Workday Rules: (These aren't likely to change.)

1. Anything with a motor and a seat will only be operated those over 18.
2. Chain saws and electric power saws will only be operated by those over 18.
- 3 Axes and other cutting tools will only be used by those over 16.
Direct parental supervision will be an allowable exception to this rule.
Hedge trimmers and clippers aren't restricted.
4. Fireworks, alcohol, drugs. Leave them home. Same goes for off-road vehicles not involved directly in camp building.

"In the Whisper" Guidelines and suggestions (These may change a bit as the types of work changes)
"In the Whisper" is in a woods. That means mosquitos, deer flies, brambles, poison ivy, thorns, raging water buffalo, and mud. (Just kidding about the buffalo.) Long sleeve shirts, and long pants are a good idea, especially in the early stages of camp construction. If you've got Carharts, they're helpful with the thorns. The terrain is rough and in many places wet. Initially we'll be clearing lots of downed trees and such, so work boots are also recommended. A change of clothes for the drive home is a good idea. As the days warm up, a dip in the lake at the end of the day is quite possible. You may want a towel. We'll have bug repellent and will normally have work gloves on hand.
