Many years ago, we decided that a missing component in the lives of teens today was a consistent sit-down meal. We strive to recreate the family sit-down-conversation-type meal together as a focus of our ministry time at our centers. Our meal makers commit to provide a family style meal that helps us provide teens a stable environment around the table where we share food and conversation. These conversations often spark deeper didiscussions during the day, and always foster our relationships with the kids beserved.

We were approached by the Wadsworth Pickleball Club at the end of this summer to ask how they could help provide assistance to us. We were able to give them some general needs, and they really went

above and beyond. Between cash donations and gift cards they provided over \$500 in resources. They also provided various drinks that we were able to give to the kids who come to our club nights.

It was exciting that we could take their generosity and immediately put it into use. Obviously, one of our biggest needs as a ministry is financial support and the donations were able to go towards our general budget. Then on top of that, the gift cards provided direct impact to teens. We regularly use food gift cards as prizes for kids in our games, and we often have nights where if you bring a friend who is new to The Garage, both the new kids and the one who brought them receive a gift card. This might be shocking to find out, but bribery with fast food gift cards is a great way to meet new students! Because of the Wadsworth Pickleball Club's generosity we were able to have a "Gift Card Extravaganza" early in the year and hype up the night. That night, we had one of our biggest attended nights and met several new students. We still have more left over that we continue to use as prizes, and a few others that are slightly larger amounts that we are able to use as leaders to take kids out for a meal and have "appointments" where we can build on our relationships on an individual level.

So, thank you to all of the individuals and groups like The Wadsworth Pickleball Club that have blessed The Garage with their partnership and support! We truly would not be able to have the impact on the teens of this community without continued support that we receive from all of you!
